Mathias Bjerre Jakobsen completes BWT Mücke Motorsport line-up for Prototype Cup Germany 2025

- Danish youngster Mathias Bjerre Jakobsen to make debut in Prototype Cup Germany series.
- Driver pairings for the 2025 season now finalised: Mathias Bjerre Jakobsen / Riccardo Leone Cirelli and Maksymilian 'Maks' Angelard / Mattis Pluschkell.
- Team Principal Stefan Mücke: "We have been closely following Mathias's development over the past two years in Denmark and have been impressed by what we've seen."

The BWT Mücke Motorsport line-up for the Prototype Cup Germany 2025 is now complete. Mathias Bjerre Jakobsen, Riccardo Leone Cirelli, Maksymilian 'Maks' Angelard and Mattis Pluschkell will be competing for the highly successful Berlin-based racing outfit during the forthcoming campaign. In Mathias Bjerre Jakobsen, BWT Mücke Motorsport have secured the services of the reigning Nordic 4 Championship title holder. Earlier this year, the 18-year-old Dane made strong progress and exhibited good pace in the 2025 Prototype Winter Series.

"I'm really proud to have the opportunity to race for Mücke Motorsport in the ADAC Prototype Cup Germany. This is a team with a rich history in international motorsport, and I'm excited to work with them," said Mathias. "The LMP3 class is highly competitive, and I'm looking forward to taking on the challenge and developing as a driver. My goal is to deliver strong results and take the next step in my career."

The switch to the Prototype Cup Germany represents a new challenge for Mathias as he pursues a career in professional motorsport. The talented youngster has already completed a test in the BWT Mücke Motorsport LMP3 racing car. "We are delighted to be able to announce the fourth driver for the 2025 season in the Prototype Cup Germany," says Team Principal Stefan Mücke. "We have been closely following Mathias's development over the past two years in Denmark and have been impressed by what we've seen."

For the first time this year, BWT Mücke Motorsport will be fielding not one but two 455-horsepower LMP3 car. The Berlin-based outfit is one of the established teams in the Prototype Cup Germany, which is contested on Formula 1 circuits and as part of the support programme to the DTM. In the 2024 season, BWT Mücke Motorsport finished third in the team championship. With its quartet of drivers now in place, the team is aiming to build on its successful record in the competition. Jakobsen will share a cockpit with Riccardo Leone Cirelli, while Maksymilian 'Maks' Angelard and Mattis Pluschkell will constitute the second driver pairing.

The 2025 Prototype Cup Germany will be held over six race weekends, each featuring two 55-minute races. The season will get underway on the weekend of 18th - 19th April at Spa-Francorchamps in the context of the 24H Series. Further destinations on the race itinerary include the Hockenheimring, Lausitzring, Norisring, Nürburgring and the finale at the Red Bull Ring in Austria. The Prototype Cup Germany will share the billing with the high-profile DTM on four occasions.

The series is contested in LMP3 cars, a class, that was created in 2015 by Le Mans and WEC organiser ACO (Automobile Club De L'Ouest) to give talented youngsters an entry into Le Mans prototype racing. The 950kg lightweight racing cars are powered by standardised Nissan V8 engines with an output of 455 horsepower. BWT Mücke Motorsport will field two Duqueine D08s in the 2025 Prototype Cup Germany.
