# Second BWT Mücke Motorsport driver confirmed for the 2025 ADAC GT4 Germany: Tobias Bille Clausen latest in a line of talented Danes

- Tobias Bille Clausen to make his ADAC GT4 Germany debut as a member of the BWT Mücke Motorsport squad
- Graduation from karting to a 476bhp Mercedes-AMG GT4 in BWT pink livery
- Team principal Stefan Mücke: "We are delighted to confirm Tobias as our second driver for the 2025 ADAC GT4 Germany season at this early stage"

BWT Mücke Motorsport are currently working flat out on preparations for the 2025 ADAC GT4 Germany. The illustrious Berlin-based outfit has now announced the signing of Denmark's Tobias Bille Clausen as its second driver for the forthcoming campaign. The 16-year-old is to make his debut in the junior series, which traditionally serves as a springboard into senior racing series such as the DTM. BWT Mücke Motorsport welcomes Clausen as the second newcomer after Axel Bengtsson for the team's third season in the ADAC GT4 Germany.

Clausen has already made a name for himself at various levels of karting and is now making the step up to motor racing. In the ADAC GT4 Germany, which is shown live or with time delay in over 90 territories worldwide, the talented youngster will drive a 476-horsepower Mercedes-AMG GT4 in the familiar pink livery of team sponsor BWT.

In making his GT racing debut with BWT Mücke Motorsport, Clausen will derive huge benefit from the more than 20 years of experience in the sport acquired by the team. The junior driver has been able to prepare extensively for the GT4 car in the Mücke Motorsport simulator in the German capital. Test drives on the race track ahead of the upcoming season are scheduled from January 2025 on. BWT Mücke Motorsport already has a tradition of bringing on talented Danish youngsters such as Michael Christensen, Mikkel Jensen and Marco Sörensen, all of who now compete as established works drivers.

Team Principal Stefan Mücke: "Tobias is a young up-and-coming talent who has already built up a good reputation in karting and proven his affinity with speed. We are very confident that we are welcoming a highly talented junior driver to BWT Mücke Motorsport. Tobias has been able to familiarise himself with a GT4 car in the course of test drives and is keen to put what he has learned into practice in an actual race setting at the earliest possible opportunity. He completed his first sessions in the Mücke Motorsport simulator programme with very good results. We are delighted to be able to confirm Tobias as our second driver for the 2025 ADAC GT4 Germany season at this early stage."

"I'm really looking forward to competing with an internationally renowned team like BWT Mücke Motorsport," says Tobias Bille Clausen. "I see my first season in motorsport after switching from karting as a learning year. At the same time, I want to make an impression and measure myself against the competition, some of whom are more experienced. I have already seen for myself the professionalism and the passion that characterise the way this team works, and I'm aware of the famous drivers who







have competed for them in the past. That's why I can hardly wait for my first race in the ADAC GT4 Germany."

The new ADAC GT4 Germany season gets underway at the Motorsport Arena Oschersleben on the weekend of 25th - 27th April 2025. Other venues on the race calendar include the Norisring street circuit in Nuremberg, the Nürburgring, the Sachsenring, the Red Bull Ring in Austria and the season finale at the Hockenheimring (3rd - 5th October 2025). All six race weekends will be staged in the context of the support programme to the ever-popular DTM.

In the 2025 season, the ADAC GT4 Germany will continue in its role as a training ground for talented youngsters. This includes the 'Road to DTM' programme. The ADAC GT4 Germany is a tried-and-tested concept that provides for two races of around one hour per race weekend and gives the drivers important track time. Two drivers share a cockpit, with a driver changeover taking place in the middle of the race. The junior series will use a fossil-free fuel from 2025. This new, climate-friendly fuel will contribute to decarbonisation, reducing  $CO_2$  emissions by 75 percent.
