BWT Mücke Motorsport to contest ADAC GT4 Germany again: Axel Bengtsson first recruit for 2025

- BWT Mücke Motorsport prepare for third season in the ADAC GT4 Germany
- Talented Swedish driver Axel Bengtsson is first signing for 2025 campaign
- Team Principal Stefan Mücke: "Axel has all the right prerequisites for achieving good results in his debut season"

Team BWT Mücke Motorsport will once again be contesting the ADAC GT4 Germany in 2025. Preparations are in full swing for the illustrious Berlin-based outfit's third season in the GT junior series, which forms part of the DTM support programme. BWT Mücke Motorsport have now announced their first signing for the new season: Sweden's Axel Bengtsson will be driving one of the team's up to 476-horsepower Mercedes-AMG GT4s sporting the eye-catching pink livery of partner BWT.

24-year-old Bengtsson is all set to make his ADAC GT4 Germany debut. Having switched from karting to motor racing in 2022, he went on to gain a wealth of experience in his home country. Last year, Bengtsson was competing in the all-electric Scandinavian Touring Car Championship (STCC), a series in which he won the Best Junior Driver title in his debut season of 2022. Bengtsson can also look back on selected starts in the Scandinavian GT4 Championship and the Porsche Carrera Cup Scandinavia.

Bengtsson's move to Germany has in no small measure been motivated by BWT Mücke Motorsport's more than 20 years of experience and extensive expertise in motor racing. "I am very happy to have signed for BWT Mücke Motorsport," says Axel Bengtsson. "I am already looking forward to the coming year with the team. I am grateful for this fabulous opportunity and am sure that we can achieve good results together in the ADAC GT4 Germany."

BWT Mücke Motorsport Team Principal Stefan Mücke was equally positive: "We are delighted to announce Axel Bengtsson as the first junior driver for our continued involvement in the ADAC GT4 Germany. He made an immediate impression on us during testing. Axel settled into the car well and was on the pace. He showed himself capable of working with the team and the engineers right from the start. He is facing a year of apprenticeship in what is a new racing series for him, but together with us, Axel has all the right prerequisites for achieving good results in his debut season."

Bengtsson and other drivers from the BWT Mücke Motorsport talent pool will be continuing their preparations for the start of the season over the winter. From January to the beginning of March, a varied programme of activities is planned in Portugal and Spain in the context of the Winter Series. The new ADAC GT4 Germany season commences at Motorsport Arena Oschersleben on the weekend of 25th - 27th April. Further stops on the itinerary include the Norisring, the Nürburgring, the Sachsenring, the Red Bull Ring in Austria and the season finale at the Hockenheimring (3rd - 5th October 2025), with all races being staged as part of the support programme to the high-profile DTM.







The ADAC GT4 Germany will continue to be a series in which great emphasis is placed on encouraging the development of the next generation of racing drivers. The 'Road to DTM' programme introduced in 2024 will be continued. As in previous seasons, the proven format of two one-hour races per weekend is retained. Two drivers share a single cockpit, with the changeover taking place mid-race. The ADAC GT4 Germany will be using a fossil-free fuel from 2025. This new, climate-friendly energy source will contribute to decarbonisation and reduce CO2 emissions by 75 percent.
